Dennis Earl Warnock, 73, of Magnolia passed away Sunday, December 20, 2020 in Shenandoah. He was born on January 4, 1947, in Topeka, Ks, the son of William and Joyce (Tibbits) Warnock.

Dennis served in the Army National Guard from 1965-1969. Where he was activated and deployed to Vietnam, May 1968 and received numerous medals while serving. He returned home late November 1969, met Connie January 10, 1970 and married that same year on May 2. They shared several memories through the fifty years that they had together.
