Anna Shaw, age 102 of Magnolia, passed away April 15, 2020, with her loving family at her side.

Anna is survived by her son Rick, daughter in law, Susan, and nieces and nephews. Anna was predeceased by her parents, William and Rose Scoggins and six siblings: Allie Scoggins, Clara Grovak, Bud Scoggins, Myrna Scoggins (infant), Ruth Chapman, and Earl Scoggins.

She was stationed at Charleston, SC where she met the love of her life, Raymond Shaw. They married and moved to Boonton, NJ where she took on the roles of wife, caregiver and mother. She was a longtime resident of Tampa, Fl.

She moved to Texas to live with her son and daughter in law after the death of her husband. Throughout the years she kept in touch with family and friends through letters and cards and treasured every one. She reached the amazing

age of 102.
