On Tuesday, April 18th, Billy Weseman, at age 88, passed peacefully into the arms of our Lord. He was born and raised in Jacksonville, Texas. The family eventually moved to Houston, where he graduated from Milby High School. He served in the Texas Air National Guard as a staff sergeant from 1948-1955. Later he attended college where he learned the electrical trade.

Mr. Weseman, a long time Pearland resident, served the Clear Lake area in his electrical contracting business, Weco, a business he started in 1965. Many of the area's landmarks, including buildings at NASA, were touched by his hands.

Through the years he participated in organizations such as Space Center Rotary, where he became the president of the club and eventually the district governor of the organization. He also was a member of the Arabia Shrine Temple, as a part of the motor corps.

Preceded in death by his mother, Beulah Mae Heaton Rideout, and father, Ernest Asbury Weseman. His wife, Martha Ann Fairchild Weseman, also passed in the last year.

He is survived by his daughters, Weida Ann Metzger and her husband Arland, Sheree Lynn Wright, and son Richard Dean Weseman.
