Carval Wayne Yarbrough was born in Galveston, Texas to Norean Yarbrough on November 21, 1934. He passed away peacefully at home in The Woodlands on August 30, 2021, at the age of 86 years, 9 months.

Carval was preceded in death by his Mother, Norean. He is survived by his wife of 67 years Patricia Nicholson Yarbrough. Also surviving is daughter, Debbie Ballinger and husband, Larry; son Greg Yarbrough and wife, Guadalupe; and son Michael Yarbrough and wife, Andrea. During this time, he became well known in the rubber industry by speaking at rubber group meetings, writing articles for magazines and receiving patents on several products.

He loved boating, fishing, traveling, and eating out. He always knew the “mom and pop” restaurants in almost every Texas city.

He was a member of The Woodlands United Methodist Church and proud of his travels to The Holy Land and being baptized in the Jordan River. Services will be conducted by Rev. Dr. Lee Brewer of The Woodlands United Methodist Church.

Carval will be greatly missed by all who knew him.
