Dan was born to David and Ruth Neisch in Odessa, Texas. He completed his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in forestry from Stephen F. Austin University in Nacogdoches, Texas. Upon graduation, Dan spent his entire career in the oil and gas industry until his retirement in 2015.

In 1978, Dan met the love of his life, Marilyn Pendlum. They were married on June 14, 1980 and went on to have three beautiful children, Julie, Michael, and Andrew.
