David John Noll, the youngest of three children, was born December 25, 1935, and raised in Canton, Ohio. In 1959, he married the love of his life, Donnie Riffle, and they enjoyed 59 years of wedded bliss. He entered the United States Air Force in 1961, and proudly served his country for the next 20 years, including a tour of Vietnam 1968-69. David received a bachelor's degree from Kent State University, and earned his master's degree in Mathematics from Stanford in 1968.

David and Donnie had four children: David James, Douglas John, Darlene Beth, and Denise Beverly. He retired from the Pentagon at the rank of Major in 1981, and relocated the family to the Houston area where he continued working for another 15 years in oil and gas, and retired from El Paso Gas in 1997. Upon his second retirement, David and Donnie moved to Magnolia, Texas where they enjoyed the peaceful quiet of country life for the past 20 years.

After his retirement, David continued to be an active member of Magnolia United Methodist Church, where he served on various committees, held positions of leadership, and also played Santa Claus for the children. At the time of his passing, Dave was the Financial Secretary for the church, managed the finances for Magnolia Fitness Center (a ministry of the church), and was Treasurer of the United Methodist Men.

David is preceded in death by their son, Harris County Deputy Douglas John Noll, parents Clyde and Marie Noll, brother Richard Huddleston, and sister Barbara Williams.

He is survived by his loving wife, Donnie; children David James, Darlene and son-in-law Daniel "Scott" Dodson of Magnolia, Texas; Denise and son-in-law Tim Kraft of San Diego, California; seven grandchildren Kristian Noll, Tiffany and husband Dane Fullerton, Ashleigh Dodson, Douglas "Cody" Dodson, Clark Frost, Carson Kraft, and Connor Kraft; and two great-grandsons Dallas Daniel Francis, and James Thomas Fullerton.

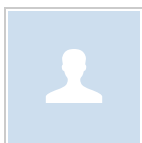
