As mentioned in Elijah's obituary, he was very excited to join the Texas Air Team. I had the pleasure of serving with Elijah for a week. He rode with me his first day and shadowed me for the week. When we left the office together, his initial comment to me was that he like to talk and ask questions. Oh boy, was that a true statement lol. At our first call, I took the time to introduce him to an air cooled chiller. Elijah came alive with excitement, questions and thankfulness. The interaction was so refreshing, for a "old timer"! For those of you reading this, please be patient, I have to get through the trade talk, in order to get to the good stuff. So, Elijah and I are playing show and tell on the Chiller mechanics, then we switched to the electronic controller display. I instructed him on how to pull temperatures, pressures etc, then I asked Elijah a trick question. Here comes the perfect response. I showed him circuits A and B, then I pulled up circuit C, which read all zeros (not good, there was no circuit on this chiller, but he didn't know it). His response shocked me. Elijah said "Lloyd, I don't know, but I'll find out". As he said that, he turned and started walking towards the rear of the chiller to investigate the mystery circuit C. His response was perfect. Every trainer dreams of that perfect trainee. For the first time in my career, I found mine, on the first call. Never, have I met a young man who possessed, at an early age, courage, inquisitiveness, positive attitude and a quick study (meaning he learned fast). The young man so impressed me, my evaluation of him was formulated on the spot. After Elijah's first call with me, I knew I was going to recommend fast tracking his training. At the end of our first day, we stopped at the office, so Elijah could pick up his work truck. While he was out with Jordan (our owner), I asked Jordan, "where did you find Elijah"? His response was Indeed, after 75 interviews. My response to Jordan was "find more". Even though Elijah, was walking back to the office, he heard every word, between Jordan and I, and turned his head towards me a gave me the biggest stuff eating grin! It was classic. Last Monday, I dropped off Elijah's birthday day cake, special made by my wife, per his preference, at the office. Duty called and I had to

roll out, not hearing the tragic news. To wrap it up, I want to focus on the blessings. For me, I only got to spend one week with Elijah, but that was a good week professionally and personally! For the family, hold tight to your memories! I only served a week with him, but he will always be in my heart.
