Fred William Andreatta, age 91, of Magnolia Texas, passed away at home on Friday June 2, 2017, after a courageous battle with cancer. Born November 14, 1925 in Uhrichsville, Ohio, he was the son of Corrado and Emma (Zandron) Andreatta. Fred graduated from Uhrichsville High School in 1943, and upon graduation enlisted in the U.S. Navy. As a part of his naval training, he attended college at Yale University, Bates College, and the University of Notre Dame. He received his officer's commission in March 1945, and was in the Pacific theater when World War II ended. After the war, Fred completed his collegiate education at Ohio State University, where he received a B.S. in Ceramic Engineering. Professionally, his career included stints at both Evans Pipe Company of Uhrichsville, Ohio, and nearly 30 years at Acme Brick Company as a division engineer based at the Oklahoma City plant. His favorite pastimes included fishing and gardening. Fred moved to Magnolia in retirement. He was a long time member of the congregation at St. Matthias the Apostle Catholic Church.

On July 24, 1948 Fred married Margaret (Kilpatrick) Andreatta who survives him. Also surviving are their children: Stephanie (Ignacio) Villanueva of Magnolia and her children Andrea (Manuel) Cantu and Chris (Samantha) Smith; Mike (Sheila) Andreatta of Edmond Oklahoma and his daughter April (Scott) Lingle; and Jack (Patricia) Andreatta of Cross Roads, Texas. Great grandchildren include: Ethan, Grayson, and Jacob Cantu; Ashley and

Christian Smith; and Luke and Hudson Lingle. His brother Gene Andreatta of New Philadelphia, Ohio, also survives him. He is preceded in death by his grandson Steven Michael Andreatta, his parents, brother Leno Andreatta, sisters Annie Boles and Erma Overholt, and son-in-law Scott Smith.
