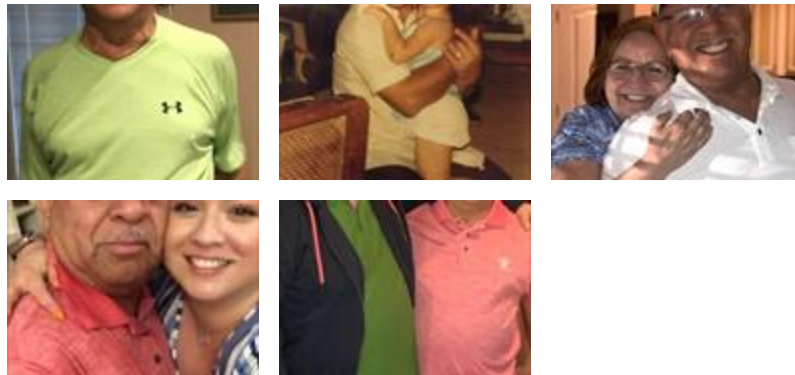
I thank God for blessing me and my brother with him as our dad. We had a great childhood. Our dad along with our mom, built so many memories with us...
