Kenneth Wayne Spencer, 77, passed away on December 3, 2018 in Magnolia, Texas. He was born on November 25, 1941 to the late Ellis and Margaret Spencer in Abilene, Texas. Ken enlisted in the Navy in 1958 and served on Active Duty in both the Navy and the Army until 1970. During this time he served in Vietnam in 1968 and 1969 as a Marine Engineer in the Army. From 1970 to 1991 he served in reserve units in several branches of service. He was on Active Duty in the Air Force Reserves as a Medical Service Technician in early 1991 during Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm. He retired from the Air Force Reserves in 1991.

After his active duty service in 1970, Ken worked in various oil related industries until his retirement in 1996. He was particularly proud of his work as a 3rd party inspector with the National Board Commission.

Ken had a tremendous sense of humor and was a very personable individual. He was an avid reader of books about military strategies and battles and enjoyed learning about the events occurring during World War II.
