Kenneth "Ken" Allen Wilson of Cut-n-Shoot, Texas, born on September 23, 1939 to Carl and Lois Wilson in Walker County, Jasper, Alabama, went to be with his Lord and Savior on January 16, 2021 in Tomball, Texas at the age of 81. After graduating from Curry High School, class of 1957, Ken proudly served 4 years as a radio operator in the United States Marine Corps, Company C, 2nd Marine division, where he achieved the rank of Lance Corporal and earned two accommodations. Shortly after relocating to the Houston area, Ken attended Local Houston Plumbers Union #68 trade school, where he earned his master plumber license, which he held for over 50 years. In 1985, Ken incorporated Wilson Services Inc. where he was able to serve the greater Houston/Conroe community, retiring in 2013. A true follower of Christ, Ken was a faithful and long standing member of MIMS Baptist Church of Conroe, TX. He was devout, steadfast in his faith, and took every opportunity to share Christ with others.
