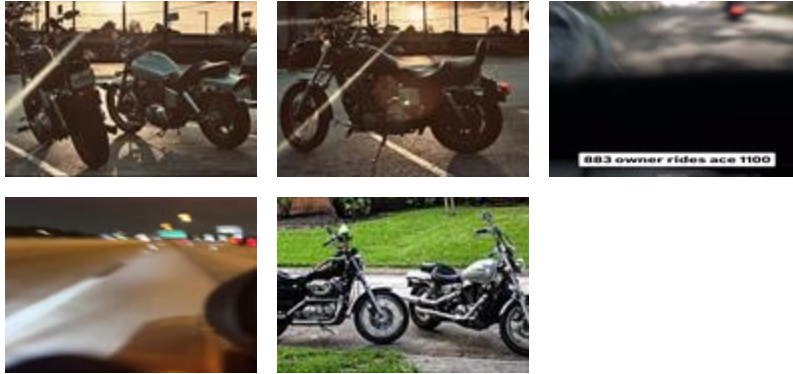

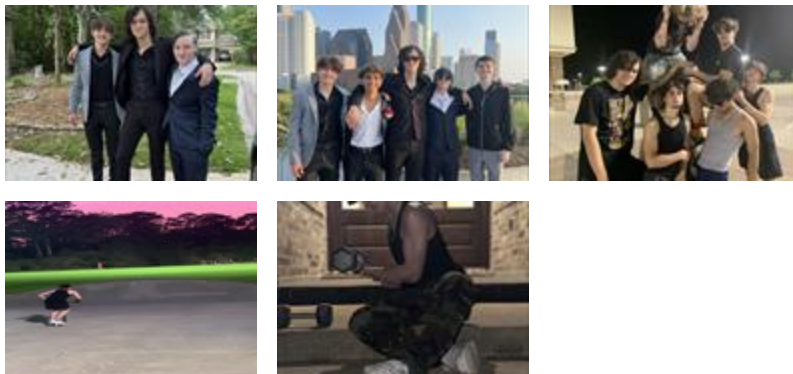

“ Dear Koji

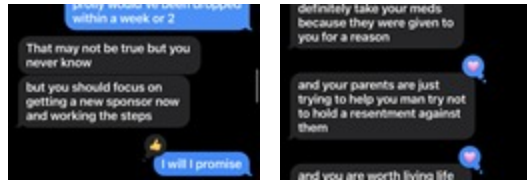

I remember when you told me that day I can call or text you in case I needed to talk, that you would always respond, and you always did. Even while battling your own struggles, you showed incredible strength by being there for all of us, and checking up when things went South.

Asking you to be my sponsor felt like a weight getting lifted off my shoulders, and to this day, I am grateful I did, as it led towards a lifetime of memories even throughout our time knowing each other. 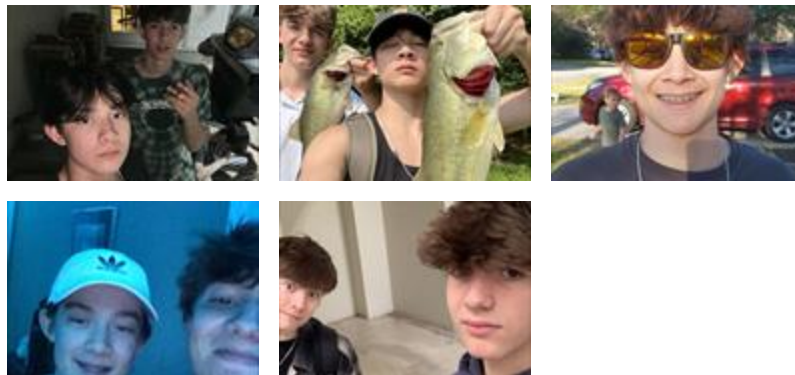
hear it, and it would help us down the road more than we ever thought, and a brother that will forever be missed in everyone's heart, whether you knew him for a minute, or a decade.

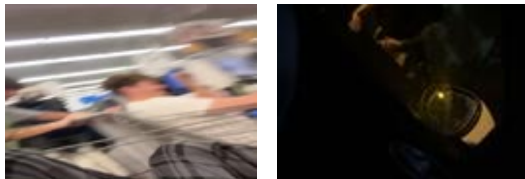

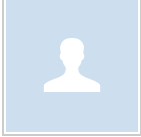
