Margaret Terrasson, 80, of Houston, Texas passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 17, 2023. She is survived by sister Edna Fraser and husband Deacon Ron Fraser; nieces and nephews Mary, Anne, Kyrn, Susan, Ron Jr, Dennis, Bernadette, Christina and Patrick; son Edward Terrasson and wife Jennifer Kwak; granddaughters Grace, Juliette, Trinity, and Lillian; son Daniel Terrasson; daughters Brigitte Terrasson and Colette Terrasson.
