US Army SFC Michael Jeremy Baggett of Sylacauga, AL passed from this life on June 19, 2022. He was 44 years old. He was born to Gary and Patricia Baggett on September 6, 1977 in Abilene, TX. He grew up mostly in Seguin, TX, graduated from Seguin High School in 1997, and entered the Army shortly after.

SFC Baggett was a decorated soldier who served in Kosovo in 1999. He served in Iraq in 2001, 2009, and 2011. He sacrificed all for his nation and the freedom of others. He was an Army veteran with 16 years active duty service, followed by US Army Reserve service, and retired in 2022 with 24 years total service. 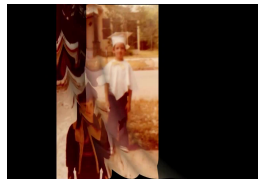
