Patrick (Pat) Mountain, 86, of Magnolia, Tx passed away November 14, 2024 surrounded by his wife and children. Pat was born to Harry and Marguerite (O'Neil) Mountain of Fairview, NJ and was the 7th of 8 children. He used to joke that the reason he did not have a middle name is that his parents had run out of ideas by the time he was born. Pat graduated from St. Joseph of the Palisades High School in 1956, where he starred in track. He served in the United States Marine Corps as a radioman from 1956-1959 and was honorably discharged with the rank of Private First Class. Pat attended Fordham University in New York City where he graduated with a degree in Business, while painting houses part-time to pay for his education. Pat took a job with Texaco, Inc. and was transferred to Houston in 1965 where he met his beautiful wife Pauline (Anderson). They were married in Houston in 1970, where they raised their 4 children. Pat worked most of his career in the Oil and Gas sector, focusing on Credit and Finance. He retired in 2008 and spent his free time working in his yard, hunting, and fishing with his sons.
