Within a few weeks of her birth, influenced by a close family member, Helen became Polly, a nickname which stayed with her for her entire life. Polly was raised in Lamesa, the middle child of 5 children. On June 12, 1970, Polly married “the boy next door,” David Barringer. They were blessed with two children, Brian Edward and Cynthia Diane. Polly was able to spend most of her early marriage as a homemaker. Later on, she joined the work force, first as secretary in both the Klein and Cy-Fair school districts.
