Randall was a devoted husband and father. He was married to the love of his life, Linda for over 60 years and is survived by Linda, their three sons Robert, Bradley, and Brett, 13 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren, and one sister Sandra Gaskins.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother Marley and Cornelia Camden, and his brother Jimmy Fields.

Randall grew up near the small town of Fisher, IL where he was raised on his family's farm. There, he discovered his love for horses at a very young age. As a young, married father, Randall helped operate the family farm and barreled Quarter Horses for extra income on the weekends. In the late 1960's Randall left the barrel racing scene and began training racing Quarter Horses. He continued in his father's footsteps operating the family farm until 2005 when he and Linda left Illinois for Texas. Throughout his racing career he raced his horses in many states where they set multiple track records and had countless wins. One of his most recent racers was nominated for "AQHA Racing Horse of the Year".

As a father, Randall was never one to miss watching his sons in their athletic competitions. He coached Little League and was a dedicated fan of his sons

across multiple sports. Randall was so dedicated to his sons, that when the school they were attending dropped their wrestling program, he and Linda agreed to leave their home and relocate to a neighboring town. This was all so that their sons could continue wrestling. Although this meant having to take on extra jobs, he and Linda held to their commitment and saw all 3 sons graduate before eventually moving back to the family farm.

Randall also enjoyed fishing. One of his favorite things to do was to spend overnights along the banks of the Sangamon River, fishing with his sons. He also enjoyed bass tournament fishing.

Randall was a man deeply connected with nature, enjoyed competitive games, and was a devoted family man. He is loved greatly and will be missed by many.

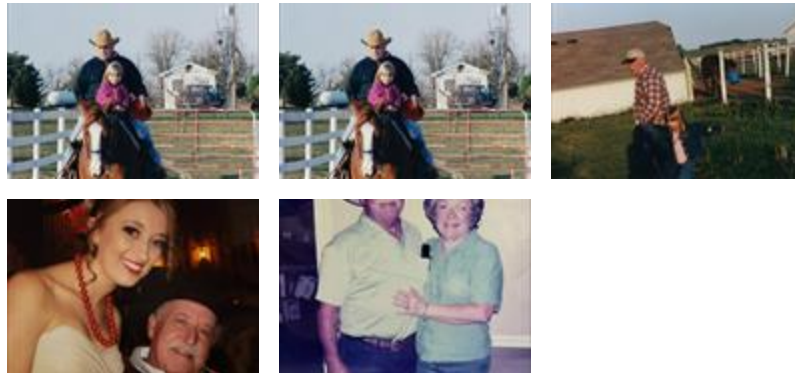
