Richard Lloyd Kreger, "Snookie," 72, of Houston, Texas, passed away on January 23, 2025, after a courageous 4.5 year fight against liver disease. 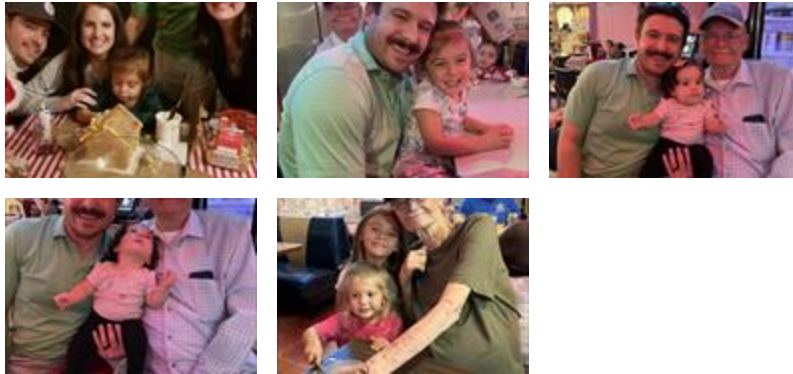
