Robert Lee Lounsbury left this earth Sunday, September 5, 2021, at the age of 73.

Robert is survived by his daughter Vickie Landeche and husband Bobby (of Hahnville, LA), son Robert Lounsbury Jr. and wife Pen (of Coldspring, TX), sister Thelma Luse and husband Joe (of Conway, SC), grandson Robert Lounsbury III (of Hutchinson, KS) loving partner Brenda Christian (of Spring, TX) and many, many friends.

Robert was predeceased by his Father Elmer Lounsbury Sr., Mother Emma Lounsbury, sister Nancy Patrick and brother Vance Lounsbury.

Born in Elkton, Maryland, Robert grew up on a farm. He spent 57 years of his life in Maryland before moving on spending time in Illinois, Florida, Louisiana, and finally settling in Texas where he spent some of the best years of his life.
