The first time I met Chip was when he greeted me as I departed a small airplane in the Kurdish capital Erbil back in 2003.

Chip was a part of our security team ensuring we could do our work under very difficult circumstances in Iraq.

The security team consisted of all British nationals except this very quiet almost shy American (Chip) who immediately stood out as being the bright and most gifted of the group.

When we parted in 2004 Chip had made a very positive impression on me. Therefore, he was always my first call when I needed somebody to watch my back going forward in Iraq.

I recall I made that phone call at least 3 times. Each time Chip signed up to work with me under extremely difficult circumstances on different contracts.

I can with certainty say Chip saved my well-being several times under duress or with sound advice. Chip is most likely one of the reasons I made it out of Iraq in one piece.

I will never forget the friendship and professional connection we built over the many years. When I departed for Afghanistan, I handed the keys to Chip knowing he would safeguard them.

Chip, your friendship and our professional association has been a privilege. I will truly miss you.
