Roy Randolph, a beloved resident of Pinehurst, Texas, passed away on April 1, 2025, at the age of 69 from an anoxic brain injury. Born in Waco, Texas, Roy lived a life filled with faith, service, and dedication to his family, community, and profession.

Roy is survived by his loving wife, Gail Randolph; his two sons, Chris Randolph (married to Lacey Randolph) and Craig Randolph; and his grandchildren Ethan, Blake, and Alyssa. He was also cherished by his siblings Joyce Williamson (married to George Williamson) and Dianna Walker. Roy's extended family includes beloved nephews and nieces: Gary Williamson, Wesley Williamson, Doak Walker, and Stephanie Crain. He was preceded in death by his brother Danny Randolph.

Roy's professional journey began at an early age. He took flying lessons at 16 in Waco and worked as a DJ on local Waco radio while still in high school. His passion for aviation led to a distinguished career as a 737 captain with American Airlines (formerly America West Airline and US Airways), where he earned the respect of colleagues and passengers alike. Later in life, Roy served as Chief Operating Officer for the family business, where he played a pivotal role in fostering his reputation for excellence in the technology and internet industry. His leadership has contributed to the growth of countless businesses since the company's founding. Additionally, Roy served on Rackspace's Email Advisory Board, showcasing his expertise in technology. Roy was deeply committed to his community. He served as a board member

of Network Texas and was an active participant in the Tomball community and the Greater Tomball Area Chamber of Commerce. His faith was central to his life; he served as a Deacon at Fairfield Baptist Church and worked alongside Gail as a Financial Peace University (FPU) coordinator for 15 years. Together, they formed lifelong friendships while helping families achieve financial freedom. Their efforts were recognized when Dave Ramsey personally presented them with the 2012 Outstanding Coordinator Award.

Known for his kindness, integrity, adventurous spirit, and unwavering faith, Roy touched the lives of everyone who knew him. He had a passion for learning and enjoyed listening to experts on aviation, technology, weather, and politics. He also loved engaging with others through social media discussions. A celebration of Roy's life will be held on Saturday, April 26, 2025, at 10 AM at Fairfield Baptist Church (27240 US-290, Cypress, TX 77433), followed by a potluck gathering to honor his memory. The service is open to all who wish to pay their respects.
