Stephen Lowell Pharr was born in Rayne, LA, to Robert Lee Pharr and Lilla Mae Bercier. He was the third child of 5. He passed away at the age of 82 on January 24, 2026.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Paulette Pharr and his 3 children: Brad Pharr and spouse Ann of Georgetown, TX; Jennifer Pharr and Spouse Nancy of Las Vegas, NV; and Scott Pharr and spouse Lisa of Houston, TX.
