Thomas Gerald "Gerry" Luther Jr was born in Mathis, TX to Thomas Sr and Louise. Gerry was the oldest of 4 siblings. Gerry grew up in Mathis where he attended Mathis High School and later would attend Del Mar College where attained an Associates Degree. Gerry joined the Air Force in 1968, after marrying his wife Elizabeth "Libby". Gerry and Libby welcomed 3 children in the next few years, Robert, Michael, and Julie. Gerry would serve a 20 year distinguished military career including time in Thailand during the Vietnam War and Europe in the mid-80s. Upon Gerry's retirement from the Air Force, the family moved to Magnolia, TX, where Gerry would begin a 35 year professional career. During the first 15 years he served as Vice President of Environmental Technologies, Incorporated and then went on to become Chief Operating Officer of Caliche, Ltd until his passing. Gerry served on many professional and non profit associations boards and committees. Gerry was preceded in death by his father Thomas, mother Louise, and brothers Leslie and Joe. Gerry is survived by his wife, Libby, son Robert and wife Dana, son Michael and wife Lizzie, daughter Julie, grandchildren Michelle, Kayla, Ashton, Avery, brother, Chris and wife Anita, and a host of sister in laws, cousins, nieces and nephews.
