



## Tim Headley

January 25, 1949 - September 26, 2018

Tim Headley, age 69, went home to be with his Heavenly Father on September 26, 2018, after experiencing a rare pulmonary embolism. Tim was born to Betty and Irvin Headley on January 25, 1949. He had three siblings: Mike, Steve and Mary.

Tim was a native Houstonian who graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School and received his Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Houston. He went on to receive a Master of Theology degree from Dallas Theological Seminary. Upon graduation, Tim began serving as a professor at the Seminario Bíblico Evangélico –ASBE in La Paz, Bolivia.

In 1980, Tim moved back to Houston where he began working as an engineer, first for McDermott and then for Fluor. Continuing his love of learning and academia, Tim attended law school receiving his Doctor of Jurisprudence degree from the University of Houston Law Center in 1985. While in law school, he met his wife, Linda Ottinger, at a Christian Legal Society meeting. Tim and Linda were married for 36 wonderful years.

Tim enjoyed a career specializing in intellectual property law with many friends in the IP-community locally and around the world. Tim also volunteered as an adjunct professor at the College of Biblical Studies, as an Angel Flight pilot

and, in recent years, as a grader of Bible correspondence coursework of prisoners through the prison ministry of Emmaus International.

Tim had many interests in addition to his profession. He loved spending time with family and studying the Bible. Tim found great pleasure in his hobbies which included flying, waterskiing, weightlifting, bike riding and writing poetry. He equally enjoyed the mountains of Angel Fire, New Mexico and the sunsets over Lake Conroe.

Tim was a passionate, generous and great man who had the heart of a servant and lived life to its fullest. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and devoted friend. He touched so many during his lifetime and will be deeply missed.

He is lovingly remembered by Linda, his four children and their spouses: Janna Headley Grigoriev and Eugene; Jen Headley Amundgaard and Ben; Heather Hoopingarner Thiel and Kyle; and Chad Hoopingarner and Emily; and by five grandchildren: Sophia and Dylan Amundgaard; Olive Thiel; and Kate and Callie Hoopingarner; and by his siblings and their spouses: Steve Headley and Bobbie; Mary Headley Jepperson and Steve; and by his sister-in-law, Zelda Headley Birge. Tim was predeceased by his parents and his brother, Mike Headley. He is also loved and remembered by his 3 nieces and 5 nephews; and by 5 great-nieces and 5 great-nephews.
