Tommy "Tom" Glass of Tomball, Texas passed away peacefully in his home at the age of 75 years old on Thursday, April 3rd, 2025.

Tommy Glass was born in Galena Park in 1949 to the late Marie and L.C. Glass. He loved his mother and father dearly. Tommy shared his birthday with his twin brother, his lifelong confidant, Donny Glass. Together, they also shared childhoods and many wonderful memories with their baby sister, the late Marie Ann (Glass) Sahadi.

Many of Tom's fondest recollections were times of youthful mischief, days of playing sports with high school friends, and stretches of hard work in the classroom. He and Don consistently excelled throughout their academic careers. Tom proudly achieved a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of Houston. He also served in the U.S. Air Force and was honorably discharged. Much of his career was spent in the oil & gas industry, where he had the opportunity to work on offshore oil rigs and travel to various countries.

The detail people most remember about Tom was his love of antiques and collectibles. Beer signs, gas pumps, wall phones, and jukeboxes were some of his favorite finds. Up to his passing, he could still remember the how, when, what, why, who, and where of each item he acquired. Some of his dearest

connections were made while treasure hunting.

Highlights of Tom's relationship with his son Brad revolved around basketball. Tom liked to join Brad in the driveway and took great pleasure watching him play for school teams. They were thrilled to witness the Houston Rockets win championships in the mid-90's and excited to attend celebration parades in Downtown Houston. Collecting basketball cards was a fun activity that garnered both of their attention. Special times in Tom's life were experienced with friends and family. He relished backyard get-togethers by the pool, holiday gatherings, and decorating the front yard for Christmas. There was an extra special place in Tom's heart for all of the family pets. His cat Buster was a faithful companion for many years.

Tom is survived by his son, Brad Glass; his daughter-in-law, Stephanie Glass; and his grandchildren, Ryan and Alysa, who lovingly referred to him as "Papa Tom". He is also survived by his brother, Don Glass; sister-in-law, Lucille Glass; nephew, Stephen Glass; niece, Tamie Glass; and niece, Renee Kennedy. Other cherished family members are niece-in-law, Dabney Glass; six great-nephews, Dylan, Devin, Holten, Wyatt, Mark, and Brandon; and two great-nieces, Megan, and Miranda. Tom was blessed throughout his life by Loraine Keuhn, "Aunt Raine"; and Bobby Dyer, "Uncle Bob".

Tom is preceded in death by his beloved mother, Marie Glass; his father, L.C. Glass; his sister, Marie Ann (Glass) Sahadi; and his niece, Cynthia Molander. Along with those closest to him, passings of extended family and close friends always deeply moved Tom.

Tom rekindled a relationship with the Lord in his last years. On his final day, Tom Glass was remembered by many neighbors in his community as someone who displayed God's love by regularly helping any person in need.
