



Vimal Adlakha

Vimal K. Adlakha, 74, of Spring, Texas, passed away peacefully at home on May 11, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born in New Delhi, India, the youngest of 13 children to Chaman Lal Adlakha and Viran Bai.

Vimal emigrated to the United States in 1976 in pursuit of a better life and married his beloved wife, Gajendra, in 1983. Together, they established a home in Spring, Texas, where they raised four children and built a life grounded in love, hard work, and perseverance.

In October 2021, Vimal was diagnosed with glioblastoma multiforme (GBM), an aggressive form of brain cancer. Despite a prognosis which has a median survival of just 6 months for patients 70 years or older, Vimal defied the odds and lived with strength and joy for another three and a half years. During that time, he embraced every moment with his family — celebrating two weddings and traveling to Austin, Atlanta, Miami, New York City, Washington, D.C., The Bahamas, and India. He lived fully and courageously until his passing.

Vimal is survived by his wife, Gajendra, and their four children: Joshua, Erica, Jason, and Samuel. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brothers Om Prakash and Vidya Sagar and his sisters Laj Vati, Sheila, Kunti,

and Indu.
