Woodrow “Woody” E. Wilson, 66 years old of Tomball, Texas passed away 5:00 am Wednesday, September 05, 2012 after a 3 ½ year valiant battle with Pancreatic Cancer.

Viewing will be Saturday September 08, 2012 from 8:30 a.m. until 10:00 am with the funeral starting at 10:00 a.m. at Magnolia Funeral Home, 811 South Magnolia Blvd, Magnolia TX 77355. Burial will follow the funeral at the onsite cemetery.

He was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, raised in Slidell, Louisiana and holds a Degree in Animal Science, though his passion was the Oil & Gas Industry.

He was married to his soul mate Teresa “Terry” Wilson and they have been together for over 23 years.
